The candidates who have applied earlier in 2018 for admission in M.Phil. or both Ph.D. & M.Phil. need not to apply again. However, the candidates who have applied earlier in 2018 for admission in Ph.D. and wants to do M.Phil. should apply through MPOnline with application fee of Rs. 500/- (as application fee for both Ph.D. and M.Phil. was Rs. 1500 and Rs. 1000 has already been paid by them for Ph.D.).

The new applicants for admission in M.Phil. may also apply but application fee for them will be Rs. 1000/-.

Last date for submission of application form is June 30, 2018. Entrance Test shall be conducted on July 15, 2018.

- A candidate for the degree of M.Phil. must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in the concerned or allied subject with at least 55% Marks (50% for SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.) of the university, a deemed university or other university incorporated by any law for the time being in force and recognized by the

University. The candidates appearing in the final semester / year examination may also apply but they have to submit their final result as per above mentioned percentage before submission of application for registration in M.Phil.

- A candidate shall ordinarily be permitted to work for M.Phil. degree in the subject in which he/she has obtained his/her Master's Degree. However, research work leads to M.Phil. degree may be allowed in allied subject of interdisciplinary nature of the same faculty or of allied faculties. Decision will be taken by the concerned Deans/ Chairpersons, BOS.
- The candidate may select the subject for the Entrance Test in which he/she has completed Master's Degree or the allied subject in which he/she wants to take admission. If the candidate qualifies the Entrance Test with the subject in which he/she has completed Master's Degree and wants to take admission in an allied subject of interdisciplinary nature, he/she may be permitted for interview in the allied subject.
- The students who have valid JRF awarded through **UGC-NET** or **UGC-CSIR-NET**; teacher fellowship for research awarded by UGC/AICTE; and any other Government / Foreign research fellowship shall be exempted from the Entrance Test but they have to appear in the interview. It is mandatory for all candidates (including the candidates who are exempted from Entrance Test) to apply online through MP-Online <https://davv.mponline.gov.in>.
- The application fee is Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) for M.Phil. Entrance Test. The candidates who have applied earlier in March, April 2018 for admission in Ph.D. and want to appear in M.Phil. Entrance Test may also apply with the application fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only). In addition to the application fee, Rs. 50/- will also be charged extra as Online Service Charges. Candidate can pay fee online through MPOnline authorized KIOSK in MP or through any ATM cum Debit Card/ Credit Card or Net Banking from anywhere. If your amount is deducted and receipt is not generated, pay the fee again, as previous amount will be reverted automatically into your card or bank account. - There is no age limit for admission in Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) programmes.
- Candidates shall be admitted in M.Phil. programmes through Entrance Test followed by an interview. The entrance test shall be conducted subject wise separately for admission in M.Phil. programmes at the University Teaching Departments.
- The Entrance Test for admission in M.Phil. is scheduled on 15-07-2018 from 11.00 a.m to 1.00 p.m. at the respective centres as mentioned on the university website. The Entrance
- The Entrance Test will have the question paper in two parts. Part-A shall consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions of 1 mark each based on research methodology. It shall be of generic nature, intended to assess the research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, data interpretation, and quantitative aptitude of the candidate. Part-B shall also consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions of 1 mark each based on the syllabus of the subject at Masters level. The duration of the Entrance Test will be of two hours. There will be no negative marking. The candidates must score minimum 50% marks in the entrance test to qualify for the interview. A list of the eligible candidates for interview will be notified by the university.

- Candidate is required to report in person for written test and interview on given date and time. Non-appearance, for whatsoever reason, will automatically disqualify the candidature for the admission.
