- This course aims to explore some aspects of the diverse and increasingly complex body of international law of human rights that has both national and international application.
- The course also seeks to analyze the ways in which allegations of human rights violations are dealt with in the courts and the impact of human rights discourse on international politics and relations..

ELIGIBILITY: Degree or Post graduate degree in any stream with 50 % marks

AGE LIMIT:

As per the directives of Government of Madhya Pradesh, there is no upper age limit for admission.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

The admissions will be done as per merit in qualifying exam.

SEATS: 40 (reservation as per state Govt. rules).

DURATION: One Semester (Six Months).
