## Rules for the award of "The President of India, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma Gold Medal".

The Medal will be awarded each year to the best student of the year of the University of any Faculty irrespective of his being under-graduate or post-graduate for 'General Proficiency' in academic, sports and games and social activities.

To judge such a student the following criteria will be followed :-

(1) Academic Performance

- (a) the student should not have failed during the years of his study in the University of Indore.
- (b) He/she should have obtained at least 60% aggregate marks in the preceding degree/post-graduate examination of this University;

(2) Extra-Curricular Activities.

- (a) He/She should have represented his/College in any Out-door games at the University level in the period of the undergraduate/post-graduate course.
- (b) Inter-Collegiate and Inter-University debates, cultural or any other such activities. These must be organized by the University/State or Central Government/U.G.C./Indian Association of Universities or any other organization brought into existence by a central or State legislation.

(3) Social Service Activities.

- (a) He/She should have actively participated in any other extra curricular activity such as NCC, NSS Adult Education and Literacy.

(4) Character and Conduct.

- (5) His/her social and moral Character and conduct should be good. While judging the best student, marks will be given for each point as follows :-

2- The detailed distribution of marks in respect of these three categories will be as under :-

## 1- Academic Performances

The percentage of marks obtained by each candidate at all the examinations of the entire degree/post-graduate course will be calculated and six marks will be allotted for every 10 marks obtained in the percentage. For the remaining marks, this will be allotted in the ratio of 10:06. In case the figure being worked to one decimal figure is upto .4, the lower whole number will be taken and if it .5 and above, it will be increased to the next higher whole no. The same rule will be applied for determining the percentage of marks.

## 2- Extra-Curricular Activities:-

- (A) Games/Sports All the sports/games activities of the students at the University level in the entire degree/post graduate degree course should be taken into account. The average score per year should be struck by the number of years he has been in that particular course in the University. Four marks will be given for every game/sports represented at the University level and three marks will be given for being the captain of a University Team.
