Participants must only send their papers in **English (Times New Roman) Or Hindi (Kruti Dev)**. If an author submits two papers, both papers must be registered separately.

Participants **seeking accommodation** are required to pay the registration fee of **INR 2,500 (Faculty)** and **INR 2000 (Scholars)**. Participants who don't need accommodation **must pay registration fees of INR 2000 (Faculty)** and **INR 1500 (Scholars)**. **Selected quality research papers will be published in an ISSN-edited book**
