SYLLABUS FOR Ph.D. ENTRANCE TEST IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

PART-A

Part-A shall consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions of 1 mark each based on research methodology (Research Methods and Statistics). It shall be of generic nature, intended to assess the research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, data interpretation, and quantitative aptitude of the candidate.

PART-B

Part-B shall also consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions of 1 mark each based on the syllabus of the subject at Masters Level as follows:

- 2. TEST, MEASUREMENT AND EVALUATION IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- 3. SPORTS JOURNALISM AND MASS MEDIA

- 6. SPORTS TECHNOLOGY
- 7. SCIENTIFIC PRINCIPLES OF SPORTS TRAINING

- 9. PHYSICAL FITNESS AND WELLNESS
- 10. SPORTS PSYCHOLOGY
- 11. HEALTH EDUCATION AND SPORTS NURTITION
- 12. SPORTS MANAGEMENT
