Unit I: Introduction to Professional Social Work

- 1) The concept of professional social work, alignment of scientific and humanitarian motives of promoting social welfare.
- 2) The basic principles and values of professional social work and their relationship to the values of Indian society.
- 3) Values and characteristics of a profession: social work as a profession and its status in India.
- 4) Social services and voluntary work.

Unit II: Methods of Social Work

- 1) Social case work: concept, principles, techniques, process; scope and limitations of practice in India.
- 2) Social Group Work: Concept, dynamics, principles, program planning and development; dynamics of self-help groups in Indian context.
- 3) Community organisation: concept and principles, understanding of urban, rural and tribal communities in Indian context.
- 4) Social Welfare Administration: concept, POSDCORB, registration process of an NGO, management of social services.
- 5) Social Work Research: concept, research design, qualitative and quantitative research, concept of universe and sampling, methods and tools of data collection.

Unit III: Human Growth and Behaviour


- 1) Human development: heredity and environment

- 5) Mental health: concept, spirituality and mental health, symptoms of common mental disorders, current perspective. Examples of best practices in mental health in India.


Unit IV: Social Policy and Social Legislation

- 4) Contemporary issues, agrarian reforms, right to education, law for women, children and differently abled.
- 5) Role of social worker in legal aid and social advocacy; public interest litigation.


Unit V: Fields of Social Work
