

**Rules for the award of Golden Jubilee Fellowship out of the Research Fund of the University**

- 1. Maximum one Golden Jubilee Fellowship may be awarded by a UTD out of the Research Fund.**
- 2. UTD desirous to award the Golden Jubilee Fellowship, after obtaining permission from the Vice-Chancellor will put a Notice of this intention on the Notice Board of the Department and also on the Website of the University indicating clearly about the eligibility criteria.**
- 3. The candidate must have cleared at least NET/DET and must have completed the Ph.D. course work successfully. Besides, candidate must be registered for Ph.D. after recommendation of the Research Degree Committee (RDC) *Or* at least must have applied for the same.**
- 4. The candidate must not have availed any other fellowship like JRF, SRF, Golden Jubilee fellowship or alike at the time of application (after joining research for Ph.D. degree)**
- 5. The amount of the fellowship will be Rs.15,000/- (Rs. Fifteen Thousands only) per month and maximum period will be two years *Or* till candidate submits his/her Ph.D. thesis whichever is earlier.**
- 6. The awardee will have to do teaching work of nearly 8 to 10 hours per week in the Department in addition to his/her regular research work.**
- 7. The awardee must be regular in the Department.**
- 8. The applicants for the fellowship will have to appear before a Selection Committee for personal interview. Depending upon the academics & performance in the interview, Selection Committee will recommend the candidate(s) for fellowship *Or* may reject all the candidates if found unsuitable.**
- 9. The Selection Committee will be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor and its constitution will be as follows:**  
  
**Vice-Chancellor or his Nominee- Chairperson**  
**Dean of the Faculty**  
**One Subject Expert**  
**Head of the Department- Coordinator**  
  
**The Subject Expert and two more will form the quorum**
- 10. The recommendations of the Selection Committee will be approved by the Vice-Chancellor.**

**11. After approval of the Vice-Chancellor, Head of the Department will issue the award letter mentioning all the terms & conditions of the fellowship. There must be clear mention in the award letter that candidate will not claim any other fellowship/ post on the basis of this fellowship.**

**12. If work of the awardee will not be found satisfactory, Vice-Chancellor has the right to terminate the fellowship on the recommendation of Head of the Department.**
