DAVV to start registration for CET from May 20

Indore: The registrations of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya's (DAVV) Common Entrance Test (CET) for over 40 courses will begin from May 20. A meeting of DAVV's newly constituted admission cell was conducted on Thursday in which exam dates were proposed and the agency to conduct the examination was finalized.

"The agency has been handed over the format of the exam form. While the date of exams has not been finalized yet, it has been pushed to the third week of the month of June," admission cell head Dr V B Gupta told TOI.

Although every year the exam is conducted in the last week of May, the decision of conducting CET was stuck in limbo for the first time.

"This delay has been caused due to several reasons including submission of the Self Study Report (SSR) for

National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and the election training," said vice-chancellor NK Dhakad.

"Now, that the submission of all the details for NAAC from the university end has been over, conducting the CET has become a priori-

ty," he said.

The procedure has been divided into three categories and 13 groups. While CET will have two main groups- A and B, which are subdivided into A1, A2, B1 and B2 for graduation and postgraduation which fall under the first category.

The procedure for admission in the second category is through the departmental-level test and it comprises of group C, D and E. Group F is divided into F1, F2 and F3 and Group G is divided into G1 and G2.

The admission in the third category which consists of Group H, I, J, K, L, and M is through merit in the qualifying exams.
