

Decide BEd affiliation, law courses recognition issue, VC to officers

Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya (DAVV) vice chancellor Prof Renu Jain on Thursday directed officers to take decision on affiliation of BEd and MED colleges and also get a clear picture from the Bar Council of India (BCI) on issue of giving recognition to law colleges.

"We are thinking of holding BEd and MED exams in January. But for that firstly we will have to grant or deny affiliation to the colleges. Besides, we also need to know from BCI which law college is having its recognition," the VC said in a meeting with exam and confidential department officials.

The VC was told that exams of nearly 20 courses including semester exams of MA, MSc and MCom and BA, BSc and BCom would be over by December end.

To this, the VC directed the evaluation centre employees to send the copies for scrutiny once they reach the university from exam centre.

"We want results of all winter season exams to be

out by January 31," she said. Jain said that the Chancellor is very serious on compliance of academic calendar: "We should also be equally serious," she said.

On being told that the affiliation process for BEd

and MED courses go on throughout the year, Jain said that this needs to change.

"If we really wants to get improve things, we need to streamline the affiliation process," she added.
