# University Level Youth Festival concludes

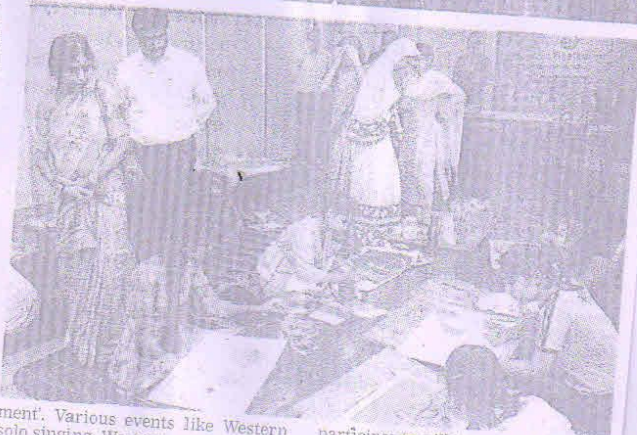
