DAVV releases admission guidelines for professional courses

Devi Ahilya Vishwa Vidhyalaya on Thursday released guidelines for admission to professional courses offered by its teaching departments. Applications have been invited till September 13 for ad-



mission to 37 courses including 19 PG, 13 integrated and 5 UG courses.

PG programmes mostly include much sought after MBA courses. The courses have been divided into three groups viz group-A,

group-B and group-C. Group A consists of PG programmes whereas group B and C comprises integrated and UG courses respectively. Group A has a total number of 1135 vacancies whereas Group B has 760 and Group C has 400 vacancies.

CHANGE IN ADMISSION PROCESS

In light of Covid-19 situation common entrance test has been cancelled and decision has been taken to grant admission on the basis of previous academics record of the student. For UG courses the weightage for admission will hinge on marks in class 10th and class 12th exam marks. While class 12th will have a weightage of 65%, the DAVV will consider 35% marks of class 10th. For PG courses, class 10th marks will have a weightage of 15%, class 12th 20% whereas graduation exam marks will have a weightage of 65% marks.

CET online registration window open till Sept 13

Indore: Devi Ahilya Vishwa-vidyalaya (DAVV) opened online registration window for courses under Common Entrance Test (CET) on Thursday evening.

Candidates will have 24 days to registration for Common Admission Process (CAP) will remain open till September 13.

No documents are required with online application form. Only signed photograph has to be uploaded with online form. The varsity conducted a meeting of five-member committee for approval of guidelines of courses under CET on Thursday. Thereafter, decision was taken to begin registration from the evening, said vice chancellor Dr Renu Jain.

This year, the varsity will also give weightage to marks of Class 10 for both undergraduate and postgraduate courses under CET programme. In undergraduate courses, 35

per cent weightage will be given to Class 10 board percentage and 65 per cent to Class 12 results. For post graduate courses, 15 per cent proportion will be allocated to Class 10 board percentage, 20 per to Class 12 and 65 per cent for undergraduate course.

"All percentages will be

rounded-off to two decimal points for calculation of merit," said media spokesperson of DAVV, Dr Chandan Gupta. The programmes have been divided into three groups - A, B and C. Group A comprises all postgraduate courses, Group B and C have undergraduate courses.
