

Steps to Add Aadhaar by Students

Following are the steps to add aadhaar by students:

1. Ministry of Minority has allowed finally verified students who has not submitted the aadhaar to submit their Aadhaar for its all four schemes.
2. To add Aadhaar, Student has to login into their NSP account.
 - a. Following are the urls to reach to the login screen:
 - i. For Fresh: -[NSP - Login \(scholarships.gov.in\)](https://scholarships.gov.in)
 - ii. For Renewal: [NSP - Login \(scholarships.gov.in\)](https://scholarships.gov.in)




Figure 1: Login Screen

 - b. Please refer "Figure 1: Login Screen" to login:

3. After successful login and in case student has not submitted the aadhaar, he/she would see the "Aadhaar Aadhaar Numer" option in the left corner of the screen.




Figure 2:Add Aadhaar Number

4. Please refer "Figure 2:Add Aadhaar Number"

5. Student shall entire and confirm his Aadhaar Number or his parent's aadhaar (in case student don't have aadhaar and age is less than 18) in the provided text input box as shown below:

7. By clicking on the submit button, an applicant/his parent (in case student don't have aadhaar and age is less than 18) would be agreeing to the terms as conditions as mentioned in the below figure

9. On click of submit the applicant's aadhaar or his parent/guardian (in case student don't have aadhaar and age is less than 18) Aadhaar would be submitted.
