Subject EBSB Campaign: Revised Activities proposed for HE Institutions

This is regarding revision in the activities proposed to be performed by higher educational institutions under the Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat Campaign. So far, pairings have been done for all HE institutions across the paired states – for example, IIT of state 1 has been paired with IIT of paired state and similarly for NITs/IIITs/ CU/ IISER/ IIMs/ RUSA funded institutions / AICTE regulated institutions.

- 2. The paired institutions were asked, vide our earlier communications, to carry out Student Exchange, Teacher Exchange, Youth Festival , EBSB Day, EBSB Club and Translation of Books of paired States.
- 3. Based on feedback from institutions, it is understood that several of them are finding it difficult to organize the Student Exchange activity owing to time, budget and other logistic constraints. The list of proposed activities has therefore been reconsidered and redrawn with focus on low cost, high volume activities which can be easily woven into the curriculum of the institution without large scale movement of students. The list of proposed revised activities is at Annexure to this letter.
- 4. All Bureau Heads, AICTE, UGC, Coordinator RUSA are requested to
  - i. Communicate the above revised plan to the institutions under their administrative control.
  - ii. The pairing of institutions that has been done already will continue for the proposed programmes.

These can include reading of books from paired states, cultural programmes, cuisine, listening to news from the paired state, listening to/ watching a language Radio/ TV News / other programme from the paired state, holding quiz about the paired state etc. In addition to the above the EBSB Clubs can lead/ drive other EBSB activities being organized by the institution.
