

Ordinance No. 240

**Bachelor of Engineering 4-Year Degree Course
in Mechanical/ Computer/ Electronics & Instrumentation/
Information Technology/ Electronics & Telecommunication/ Civil Engineering
Under Faculty of Engineering DAVV, Indore**

1. Name of Program:

Bachelor of Engineering in Mechanical/ Computer/ Electronics & Instrumentation/ Information Technology/ Electronics & Telecommunication/Civil Engineering.

2. Name of Faculty and Board of Studies:

Faculty of Engineering - Board of Study of the respective branch of Engineering

3. Duration:

Full time program shall comprise of the course of study spread normally over a period of four years i.e. eight semesters. The maximum duration of the course shall be eight (08) years i.e. sixteen (16) semesters.

4. Eligibility and Admission Process:


- (i) The minimum qualification for admission to the first semester is successful completion of the qualifying 10+2 exam of MP Board or any other equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects and Chemistry/ BioTechnology/Biology as one of the subjects. The candidate must have secured minimum of 45% marks (40% for SC/ST/OBC of MP domicile).
- (ii) The candidate who has passed diploma examination from M.P. Government Technical Board in appropriate Branch of Engineering will be eligible for admission to the first semester of four year degree course.
- (iii) The candidate who has passed diploma examination with the first division from M.P. Technical Board in appropriate branch of Engineering / B.Sc. with Mathematics as one of the subject will be eligible for admission to the third semester (second year) of four year degree course (lateral entry).
- (iv) The eligible candidate as specified in above rule (i), (ii) and (iii) will be admitted by the procedure specified by the University Statutory bodies.
- (v) The eligibility norms are subject to change as per guidelines from the appropriate statutory body/bodies.

5. Fee Structure:

- (i) The fees structure shall be as per approval of Executive Council/State Govt. and as applicable from time to time.
- (ii) University examination fees, eligibility and enrolment fees etc. shall be as per University rules from time to time.

6. Examination Scheme, Curriculum & Related Regulations:

The curriculum, examination scheme and award of marks to theory, laboratory and projects will be as per 'General Rules and Regulations' approved by the Academic Statutory body of the Faculty of Engineering.



7. Eligibility for the Award of the Degree:


Before awarding the degree a candidate must pass all the theory/ practical subjects. A candidate is said to be detained who falls short of attendance as per norms and who fails in any Class Work (CW)/Sessional Work (SW). He /She shall have to seek fresh admission in the subject whenever admission is available.


8 Attendance:

Attendance in theory and practical classes shall be compulsory. Minimum attendance for appearing in examinations is 75% in theory and practical separately.

9. General Instructions:

- a. The candidate who seeks admission in odd semester of an academic year is said to be in AB Group while a candidate who seeks admission in an even semester of an academic year is said to be in BA Group. A candidate who has appeared in the odd semester (AB Group)/even semester (BA Group) of any particular year will go to even semester (AB Group)/Odd semester (BA Group) of that year irrespective of failing in any number of theory or practical examinations of that semester.
- b. The candidate will be promoted to the available semester of the next academic year provided he/she does not carry a backlog of more than a combination of five theory and practical (taken together) subjects of the immediate previous year.
- c. A candidate will not be permitted to appear in the examination, which she/ he has passed earlier.
- d. A candidate, who has failed in more than five theory papers or a combination of more than five theory and practical (taken together) papers, will become ex-student of the Institute.
- e. A candidate should have no backlog of the lower class i.e. a candidate will not be admitted to the third year if he/she has failed in any subject (Theory or Practical) of the first year. Similarly he/she will not be admitted to the fourth year, if she/he has failed in any subject (Theory or Practical) of the second year.
- f. Candidate failing in any examination may, subject to other provisions of this ordinance, be readmitted to the examination in the failing subjects in the subsequent semester without necessarily prosecuting a further course of regular study in the institute.
- g. No candidate will be awarded degree of Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) unless he/she has passed all the eight semester examinations. Final degree and mark sheet shall be awarded only after successful completion of the program i.e. after passing theory and practical examinations of all the semesters with the minimum required Class work and Sessional work marks.
- h. The candidate, pursuing seventh semester after eighth semester (BA Group) will not be issued degree mark-sheet or provisional degree certificate after eighth semester, until he/she has passed all the semester.
- i. With a view to avoid an accidental failure in an examination the following shall be observed:
 - (i) A maximum of only five marks shall be awarded to a candidate as grace marks in one theory in each semester examination, taken in full. No grace marks shall be awarded if examination is taken in part.
 - (ii) The grace marks so awarded shall not be added for the computation of the aggregate marks obtained in the semester.
 - (iii) After condoning the above deficiency the result shall be declared in the division to which the candidate is entitled with the provisions of this ordinance.
- j. For the matters not covered in the ordinance or any required modification, the Executive Council, shall be the competent authority to decide.
