~~Subject to the general rule of promotion from odd semester to even semester, a candidate shall become ex-student of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year, LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year and LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year as under :~~

- ~~(a) Ex-student in LL. B. (Hons.) First Year - If he carries a backlog of three or more papers (Theory and/or Practical) in First and/or Second Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year.~~
- ~~(b) Ex-student in LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year - If he carries a backlog of three or more papers (Theory and/or Practical) in Third and/or Fourth Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year.~~
- ~~(c) Ex-student in LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year - If he carries a backlog of any paper (Theory and/or Practical) in Fifth and Sixth Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year.~~

8. Attempt for Regular and Ex-candidate :

- (i) A candidate carrying a backlog of one or two papers in LL. B. (Hons.) First Year as a regular candidate at the time of examination of Sixth Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year shall be deemed to be an Ex-candidate on and after declaration of his result of the said examination (till he passes the same within the maximum limit of six years from the date of his initial/original admission in First Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year of any academic year).
- (ii) A candidate carrying a backlog of four or less than four papers (inclusive of a backlog of one or two papers of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year) in LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year as a regular candidate at the time of examination of Sixth Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year shall also be deemed to be an Ex-candidate on and after declaration of his result of the said examination (till he passes the same within the maximum limit of six years from the date of his initial/original admission in First Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year of any academic year).

- (iii) A deemed ex-candidate carrying a backlog of any paper(s) inclusive of backlog of any paper of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year and/or LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year and/or an Ex-candidate carrying a backlog of any paper of LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year shall be entitled to pass his backlog of all the papers within the maximum limit of six years from the date of his initial/original admission in First Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year of any academic year.
- (iv) If the candidate fails to pass the backlog of papers within six years he shall cease to be a deemed ex-student and/or ex-student as the case may be and shall be required to take new admission as a regular candidate LL. B. (Hons.) First Year according to the rules applicable for the time being in force.
- (v) A candidate fail in aggregate in any semester and carrying any semester by reason thereof in LL. B. (Hons.) First Year, LL. B. (Hons.) Second Year and/or LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year on or after the declaration of his result of Sixth Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) Third/Final Year shall also be deemed to be an Ex-student. He shall be entitled to pass the backlog of semester for passing in aggregate within the maximum limit of six years from the date of his initial/original admission in First Semester of LL. B. (Hons.) First Year of any academic year. If he fails to pass the backlog of the semester by passing in aggregate, he shall cease to be a deemed ex-candidate and shall be required to take new admission as a regular candidate in LL. B. (Hons.) First Year according to the rules applicable for the time being in force.

9. Revaluation of answer books shall be allowed as per provision of Ordinance No. 6.

10. The subjects and papers for each year of LL. B. (Hons.) shall be prescribed by the Faculty of Law on the recommendations of the Board of Studies. Unless otherwise provided each paper will carry 100 marks and will be of 3 hours duration.

11. If not provided otherwise the candidates will have to pass separately in written papers and practical, if any prescribed.
